CAMBRIDGE COMMODITIES POWER OF SPORT

- Addressed the needs of young people or under-represented groups in sport, eg Black and minority ethnic groups, people with disabilities, low income groups or older people (over 45)
- Increased the take up of sport, or addressed the drop off in participation post school age
- Demonstrated the "power of sport" to change lives

During the past year this school will have:

- Given its pupils a wide range of opportunities to participate in high quality PE and extra-curricular sport
- Shown continual commitment to school-club links

- Evidence of supporting local community sport eg sponsoring or supporting events and / or clubs
- Evidence of supporting workforce to volunteer in community sport
- Key achievements relating to sport and physical activity

- Nominations accepted for individuals living in, competing for a club/school or born within, the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough area

- To be nominated for the 'Sports Performer of the Year' the individual would have performed at the Olympics or Paralympic Games 2012 and/or on the highest level of World Class Performance for their sport
- To be nominated for the 'Disabled Sports Performer of the Year' the individual would have performed at the Paralympic Games 2012 and/or on the highest level of World Class Performance for their sport
